My Friend,

Police reports say that they found a 2-year-old boy, unable to speak, crawling on a stove in a meth lab trailer near Sacramento. It is one of the few details we have about my friend Jareome's dark childhood.

I'm writing today to ask for your help. Too many kids are in dire need of a supportive environment to grow and thrive in.

Jareome was born into a disaster zone. Even as a baby his life lacked any routine. He was hidden away, often forgotten, unfed, and uncared for. Strangers drifted in and out of the crack house where he lived. Against all odds, he survived in this environment for five years.

In all the chaos, the *only hint of stability* Jareome had was his mother. But her life was taken in a tragic accident. At 5-years-old, Jareome was alone.

You won't be able to fully comprehend what this child has been through. But will you please join me in trying to feel *and heal* his pain?

This isn't just a story – this is a human being's life.

I met Jareome when he entered our summer program two years ago. The trauma of his entire young life had taken a vicious toll on his physical and emotional health. He was on a strict schedule of medications, and could not be left alone for a moment.

Jareome's great aunt and uncle took him into their home a few years ago and they can't say enough about how Playmakers has supported him, and their family. "When I got him he couldn't read or write. All he wanted was a friend, but he didn't know how to make one," says his aunt.

Throughout the next weeks, the coaches and mentors at Playmakers showered Jareome with love, provided predictable structure, and showed him how good life can be.

The change we have seen in this kid – it's incredible! Jareome was completely un-socialized when he arrived. He threw fits and pushed people away. Others wrote him off. But we didn't. Today his attitude is respectful, and he tells me that everyone at Playmakers is his friend.

Because of Playmakers, Jareome is not just better behaved, he is doing great in school too! He is an unbelievably smart and articulate kid! He's like a little computer. He loves to learn, and he loves being around people. Jareome has found joy!

But Jareome isn't the only kid that needs help.





Within five miles of where you sit right now, there's another child who needs support. There's a child who needs guidance, opportunity, and training to grow into the man or woman they are capable of becoming.
